When he designed the Ball wall lamp back in 1969, Benny Frandsen had no way of knowing just how many books and magazines it would come to cast its cozy light upon. The iconic sphere, whose built-in magnet makes adjusting the light a snap, is ideal for reading while seated or lying in bed. It's also a great way to decorate a room with light and shadow.

Ball played its way into the hearts of many Danes during the 1970s when, as it was characteristic for that decade, it was often painted orange or brown. Since then, Ball has established itself as a classic. The form is timeless and matches any interior style. It works brilliantly with the colors of the moment, but also celebrates metallic surfaces in all their many fantastic finishes.
