TWO-COLOUR



Described by Belgian designers Muller Van Severen as a marriage between two materials used at their best, the Two-Colour table series is inspired by the contrasts and similarities in the materials used. Featuring steel tube legs for optimal strength and stability, the table surface is crafted in organic coloured Valchromat – a unique kind of robust MDF material that is FSC-certified and features a water-based lacquer. Both components are united by the even thickness, creating a uniform silhouette that is disrupted by the contrasting elements of colour. Two-Colour is available in different shapes, sizes and colour combinations, all offering a distinct personality that makes it ideal for a wide variety of environments, from cafés and restaurants to homes and office spaces.

MATERIALS

TABLETOP

30 mm Valchromat, an organic coloured MDF material with water-based lacquer incl. a small amount of colour pigment. Visible wood fibres.

FRAME

Powder coated steel tube frame and legs. High gloss 90. Round tables with square support. Rectangular tables with rectangular support with centered cross bar.

ADJUSTABLE GLIDER Integrated screw-in adjustable glider in plastic. Adjustable up to 12 mm.

CONSTRUCTION


Steel tube frame with tabletop in 30 mm coloured Valchromat. The frame is a knock-down construction that requires assembly. Legs are assembled to the frame with screws. Tabletop comes with threaded inserts, and is assembled to the frame with screws. The tables come with height adjustable gliders to handle any uneven floors.

COLOUR & FINISH

Please note that the colour codes are indicative.



The material consists of natural wood fibres that give each table top a unique expression. The organic dyeing process means the fibres and colours vary slightly from batch to batch. Minor differences in the surface are a natural part of the material and may occur.
